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# Scope of Work: Bookliberator

This document provides an outlined scope of work for the Bookliberator project, to be developed by Bad Idea Factory on behalf of Question Copyright.

## Functional Specification

MVP Android application that allows the user to:

- Register a new “book” to scan.
- Edit book metadata (e.g. title, author, ISBN, etc).
- Take a picture of book pages in sequential order and run OCR on that page.
- Export a text-based PDF of the book pages to the Android documents (or export through another similarly convenient means).
- Re-start a previously started book scan that has not yet completed.

This MVP does NOT allow the user to:

- Scan multiple books in parallel (e.g. start scanning one book and stop part way).
- Manually edit the text of an OCR'd page book.
- View a history of their book scans.
- Upload scanned books to third party services directly (e.g. Internet Archive).

## Key Milestones / Timeline

1. Wireframes outlining application key frames (Due: February 1, 8 hours)
2. Development of MVP functionality (Due: April 1, 80 - 100 hours)
